Inspection Description:

This is an assessment of defensible space, home hardening and vegetation management. This prescription will help you become more fire safe as we work toward improving all homes in our community. Inspection Topics:

Zone 0 (Structure to 5' from Structure) :

Roof / Gutter Cleaning

Remove leaves, needles, and other vegetation that has collected on the roof and in the gutters. It is recommended to clean your roof and gutters several times per year, especially during Fire Season. The Vegetation Management Grant may be utilized for this project.

Trees over Roofline

Cut back tree branches 5' from the roofline to help minimize the amount of vegetative debris that can collect on your roof and in your gutters.

Below Decks, Balconies and Stairs

Remove all stored combustibles under decks, balconies, and stairs. Keep these areas clean of debris. Combustible materials stored under these types of structures creates a vulnerability for the home in the event of a wildfire.

Foundation Perimeter

Removing combustible material in the first 5' provides a fuel break. Placing small rock or non-combustible material along your foundation/siding will help create a low maintenance, non-combustible area closest to your structure. The Vegetation Management Grant may be utilized for this project.

Annual Grasses

Remove annual grasses to bare mineral soil in Zone 0 (structure to 5'). The Vegetation Management Grant may be utilized for this project.

Dead / Dying Vegetation

Remove all dead and dying grass, leaves, shrubs, branches, and trees in Zone 0 (structure to 5').

Fire Hazardous Vegetation

It is recommended to remove fire hazardous vegetation such as Juniper, Cypress, Bamboo, Rosemary, Broom species, and Fountain Grasses from Zone 0 (structure to 5'). These types of vegetation contain high amounts of oil which makes them highly flammable. When they burn, they produce extreme radiant heat and fire embers. The Vegetation Management Grant may be utilized for this project.
